Discrimination - The HIV Anti-Discrimination Center (which includes legal support, training, a documentation center, activism and research) is a nationwide project.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE ORGANIZATION:

SER+, the Portuguese Association for the Prevention and Challenge of AIDS, founded in 1997, is a non-governmental, non-profit organization registered as an IPSS whose mission is to promote integrated responses in terms of prevention, diagnosis, treatment, discrimination and social support in the area of HIV and Viral Hepatitis, involving and empowering entities and populations.

Its main objectives are: (1) to increase the proportion of individuals who know their serological status (HIV, Viral Hepatitis and Syphilis) by ensuring linkage to care for reactive cases; (2) to reduce new infections by intensifying prevention efforts; (3) to improve the quality of life of people living with HIV, Hepatitis and vulnerable populations; (4) to reduce stigma and discrimination against people living with HIV, Hepatitis and vulnerable populations; and (5) to produce and contribute to scientific knowledge in the area of HIV and Hepatitis.
